<i>Current Level of Performance Data (0)</i>	Pre-made trainings as well as pre-post knowledge quizzes are available for EBP's. There has been an identified need around create these materials for parents as well direct services providers.
<i>Initial Objective (1)</i>	Create a bank of premade pre/post knowledge satisfaction survey (that utilizes a likert rating scale) for a parent/care provider, and/or direct service provider lens to help assist with training.
<i>Secondary Objective (2)</i>	Coaching using these materials in a structured environment with the expected level that they are able to implement.
<i>Expected level of Outcome (3)</i>	Then matching samples of the concepts in the applied setting with the provider directly working with the individual.
<i>Exceeds Expected Outcome (4)</i>	Cadre will disseminate applicable EBP's that have been trained to first responders based on regional trainings.
