Goal Area 1 (Collaboration): How can the cadre collaborate to address the region's specific need, issue or challenge that relates to autistic individuals and their families

<i>Current Level of Performance Data (0)</i>	Consistent cadre attendance at regional meetings has been challenging the past year. Low attendance has limited the cadre in
<i>Initial Objective (1)</i>	Increasing Attendance CAPTAIN cadre meetings 4 out of 6 times per year
<i>Secondary Objective (2)</i>	Each Central Valley cadre member will have the opportunity to support goals and projects/events.
<i>Expected level of Outcome (3)</i>	Shared ownership within the Central Valley cadre will result in the cadre being able to support a larger population.
<i>Exceeds Expected Outcome (4)</i>	All regions within the Central Valley cadre are fully represented within all goals and projects/events.

Goal Area 2 (Dissemination): How can members of our regional network strategically disseminate to groups identified by the region as needing to know about autism and EBPs/CAPTAIN

<i>Current Level of Performance Data (0)</i>	During the academic year of 2023-2024 the Central Valley cadre awarded 3 teachers from FCSS with implementation awards.
<i>Initial Objective (1)</i>	Each SELPA selects a candidate to coach for implementation.
<i>Secondary Objective (2)</i>	Implementation process in progress for selected candidates
<i>Expected level of Outcome (3)</i>	3 out of 5 SELPA's represented within the Central Valley cadre will submit implementation awards for educators within their own SELPA.
<i>Exceeds Expected Outcome (4)</i>	4 out of 5 SELPA's represented within the Central Valley cadre will submit implementation awards for educators within their own SELPA.
